## FAMILY BUSINESS

Raised in a family that was very active in serving the broken and poor, Jane learned not to judge a book by its cover yet, when she took a nursing job at a women’s prison nearby it became clear to her that she had very stereotypical ideas about inmates. *“Over the two years I worked in that prison I learned how to truly love the ladies I served. Some of them became my best friends.”* God opened her eyes to just how beautiful His precious Daughters are meant to be.



*“Over the years the Lord led me into many other positions where I was able to use the gifts God had given me.”* Then one day she heard that her church was going into a women’s prison with Daughters of Destiny. It had been 40 years since her last experience working with women inside a prison. *“God tapped my heart and I knew I was supposed to go. All I had to do was say yes.”*

When Jane went inside again as a vocalist on the worship team she noticed much of the prison system had changed. But what had not changed was the broken women. *“Right away the Lord led me to interact with a young woman just a couple of years into her life sentence for murder. My heart broke for her.”* Even though Jane had never been incarcerated she had been down her own road of brokenness and sin. A life journey of bad marriages, depression and bad choices had brought her to her knees before the Lord. Now married to the man God chose and walking in righteousness she had a lot to share.

*“The chaplain gave me permission to write her and I have been her discipleship mentor for three years now. She has never asked me for anything, but I pray for her every day and have sent her some great books.”*

On Jane’s second time going inside with Daughters of Destiny her son Seth joined the worship team playing drums. He shared his own testimony of God’s grace pulling him back from darkness to life. Then one day her daughter Shan asked, *“Mom I really have a heart for these women, can I come along?”* When dad joined the team for the Christmas event it became a family business in kingdom work.

*“I am so happy for the Lord to use me and my family this way. That even after many years He called us to serve in this vineyard for Him.”* ✨

# Daughters **FREE**

*Evette* "My parents were alcoholic drug addicts who fought constantly. I hated who they were and swore to never become like them." Then at 14 her mother took her to a bar and showed her how to use drugs. She so wanted to be part of her mom's life that Evette became just like them after all.



"Drugs became my way of life." It wasn't until she wrecked her car with her little girl inside that God got her attention. "I lost custody of my sweet child and went to prison, but God had a plan for me." He sent a woman into the prison who took the time to disciple Evette. She wrote her and sent cards. "I was so alone and it meant so much to hear my name at mail call. She gave me Jeremiah 29:11 as my verse to stand on and remind me that God had a plan for me."

When Evette was released from prison she knew she had a big decision to make; to go forward or go back to her old life. "I had promised God that if He would get me through prison I would walk with him for the rest of my life." Evette walked into a church alone. The pastor noticed her and asked her if she needed help. Sobbing, her face buried in her hands, she explained to him that she had just been released from prison and wanted to follow Jesus but didn't know how. He said, "You need to speak with a woman." She looked up and it was the very same woman who had met her in prison and was writing her the entire time. God was faithful.

Today Evette works as a real estate agent and attends nursing school. Her entire family is restored and she speaks in prisons and girls homes sharing the witness of God's power and love.

*Sheila* "Who am I? I am a redeemed child of God, bought back from death by my savior Jesus." Meet Sheila. Today she is a beautiful woman of God who seeks His face daily; transformed from the sexually and physically abused girl who felt unloved and alone, making choices that led her to prostitution, drugs and eventually prison.

*"I was saved when I was 21 years old, in and out of jail & prison and programs where Jesus allowed me to find Him little by little."*

Sheila has been out of prison for two years now and is grateful for the Godly women God brought around her as mentors. She would love to get into school, but must now care for her mother. "My prayer is that He will continue to help me grow in my faith, be a role model for my daughter and love my mom through her illness while I become the woman He intends me to be."
