Working as a dental hygienist has been my career for many years. It never crossed my mind to enter a prison. When I was invited to go to the Idaho Women's prison in Pocatello five years ago I was very hesitant. I stood in the parking lot and asked God, *“Why do you want me here? You know I am afraid of the incarcerated.”*

This happened to be a time in my life when I was really searching for direction. I had been experiencing intense neck and back pain from working with difficult periodontal patients. I felt it was time for a change and I was asking God for help. I didn't know how going into a prison could help, but I was obedient to the call.

I remember that first day very clearly. I was with a group from my church. We were cleared to go into the prison. I walked down several halls and was let into a meeting room. There were inmates seated in rows of chairs. I noticed that many of them carried a Bible. As I looked at these ladies my fear began to go away. Our eyes met and I felt God pouring an overwhelming love into me for them. Peace came over me and I knew that I was supposed to be in that room with those ladies. It was a divine appointment by God.

Being obedient to God has always blessed me and this time was no exception. As I continued to go into the prison and minister to His Daughters Inside He gave me the direction for which I had been praying. It came in the form of the realization of a dream. My dream had been to someday own a boutique.

With the urging of the Holy Spirit I began to test the waters toward making it happen. Could I actually open a boutique in Pocatello, Idaho? I stepped out in faith and as I did so all the doors flew open. Cyndy Louise Boutique became a reality.

The boutique really belongs to God and it is more than just a store. It is an extension of the ministry to His Daughters Inside. Upon release, she is invited to the boutique to be dressed for success. Through the blessings of God I am able to provide a woman with clothing needed for job interviews, going into a church and just plain feeling good about the way she looks.

Following God's direction helped me in another area of my life as well. Before I went into the prison I was afraid to speak in front of people. Around seventy five women now attend our services and I openly share without any fear. My husband has also joined the team and we are pleased to show the women what it looks like to be in a godly marriage. Prison ministry has become such a blessing in my life. I feel so close to God when I'm with the ladies and they bless me more than I could ever imagine. ✨
