"When we were invited to go to the Geneva Youth Correctional Facility I wasn't really sure what to expect, but I wanted to serve God. I wanted to show these girls they were loved. So I went" said Jackie "and I invited my granddaughter, Abby." This was not the usual activity a grandmother and her granddaughter share, going into prison. "I was surprised at how many young ladies came to the chapel, I thought a few might come, but it was packed. I love my granddaughter and these girls seemed a lot like her. They had the same struggles, fears and concerns that many young women have; a need for love, security and acceptance. I was so blessed to encourage and pray with them."

"This was something I had never experienced or thought I would," said Abby who is 17 and about to graduate from high school. "I was really touched by one girl that came up to me for prayer. She was just sixteen and almost ready to have a baby. Instead of asking for prayer for herself she asked if I would pray for her unborn baby and the baby's dad who was also locked up. I was amazed at her faith and trust in Jesus during such a tough time."

"My whole impression of incarcerated women has changed by this experience," said Abby. "Now I know that people in prison are not all like what I have seen on the cop shows or court TV. These were girls just like me, but not so blessed to have a loving and supportive family like I have had growing up."

Jackie said, *"Getting out my routine and going into the prison to 'just love' these girls reminded me that God is faithful. He loves all of us so much. He will never leave us or forsake us. Whatever we go through He is right there with us."*

Like so many other volunteers Jackie and Abby felt they received more blessings from the girls than any encouragement they could have given. As a result of their obedience to God He is blessing them with new energy and revelation in their own lives. Dana “As a little girl, I just knew I didn’t measure up and felt so insecure inside.” By her teenage years the enemy had been relentless in convincing Dana that she was worthless. “At 21, after years of emptiness, I fell in love with a man. We soon had a beautiful baby girl, but I was heartbroken when he began to beat me on a regular basis. I turned to drugs and gambling as a distraction from my miserable life.” Dana’s criminal activity eventually got her arrested and sent to Federal Prison.



“Inside I was searching for a purpose in life. I tried yoga and other humanistic avenues.” Then a girl invited her to church. “One week later I gave my life to Jesus.” Dana was faithful to the Lord her entire five year prison sentence. “The worst part was that my daughter was with my abuser. I had to trust God to protect her.”

Today Dana is the Editor and Publisher of the Christian Bee newspaper reaching the West Coast. She is also in the process of opening a transitional home for broken women and children. “Jesus taught me to give back and serve and He would do the rest.”

Diane Imagine a child being sexually abused by her own father. That’s what happened to Diane. “I thought my dad was supposed to protect me, instead he was my worst nightmare.” Due to this abuse Diane felt like she was worthless and abandoned. “To relieve some of the pain I would intentionally burn myself; until I discovered illegal drugs. I dropped out of school and ended up in prison.” While incarcerated ladies from the outside came in to share the gospel and Diane asked Jesus into her life.



Since her release Diane has been going back to school to earn her GED. She is also raising her daughter under the Word of God and continues to follow Jesus. “I know He loves me and has a plan for me. I am His Daughter with a Destiny.”
