As our relationship grew we became the family she could count on for encouragement when she was down and advice as she was faced with important decisions. My husband and I are equally blessed by her presence in our lives. We have a new sister in Jesus and our church has another faithful servant.

Women, wherever we are, are not so different. We all want someone to hear our heart, know our desperate fierce love for our children and that we will fight and never give up. We just need the hope only Jesus can give. In my darkest years with my son God gave me hope through His Word according to Zechariah 9:12, *I am a “Prisoner of Hope”.* I know God will use us to make a difference in another person's life.

As we celebrated her birthday at our home, with her children and grandchildren there for the first time, I made a wreath of flowers for her hair.

Mona As a young woman, Mona endured serious ridicule because she was overweight. “When someone told me cocaine would take off the pounds I immediately started using. Within a very short time I was thin, but totally addicted.” Even when informed by her doctor she would soon die if she didn’t quit smoking cocaine, Mona couldn’t stop.



Two weeks after being told she needed a lung transplant, Mona was busted for selling cocaine. “I was very sick my first year inside. When Daughters of Destiny came into the prison I accepted Jesus as my Savior.” Mona began learning how to follow Jesus and during this time the most wonderful thing happened. “I didn’t deserve it, but God healed me. I could breathe again, my lungs were clear.” Almost five years later Mona was released, a new woman. “I now and will forever live for Jesus 24-7!”

Stephanie Something was missing in Stephanie’s life, value. “I believed the lie that I was unworthy. I got involved in drugs and made a lot of bad choices.” As her life spun out of control she began using and selling Meth. “Eventually I landed in prison.” Stephanie felt so much guilt and shame over ruining her life and being separated from her little daughter that she attempted suicide.



“As I lay in the psychiatric hospital recovering, the pastor from the community church came to see me and led me to the Lord.” The women from the church also came around her with letters and prayers as she completed her prison sentence. “I am now part of that church where I feel loved and welcome. I know I am valuable to God.” Stephanie’s main job right now is full-time mom, but as a Daughter of Destiny she is ready to welcome other women as they leave prison and come into her church.
